Juanita High School PTSA Awards

Each year JHS PTSA looks for input from JHS staff, parents, students, and community. The PTSA seeks recommendations in identifying exceptional advocates and volunteers within our school community. Awards are presented to honorees at JHS in several award categories.

<u>The Golden Acorn*</u> is presented to an individual who has given outstanding volunteer service to ALL students and has demonstrated commitment to helping them achieve their potential, beyond what is recognized as part of a person's responsibilities, duties of office, or job.

<u>Juanita Rebel Award*</u> goes to a staff member or parent who has been exceptionally professional in his/her performance and personally supportive to Juanita staff, students and the community.

<u>Juanita Outstanding Citizen Award*</u> is given to a parent or community member for continued and dedicated service at Juanita High School. In determining eligibility for this award, the person's volunteer efforts should be considered in all areas of the school's programs including PTSA and other activities.

<u>Outstanding Educator*</u> is presented to the staff member who goes out of his or her way to help all students at Juanita through educational support.

<u>Outstanding Staff Award</u>*- Is presented to the staff member who goes out of his or her way to support Juanita High and its students. Recommendations should show how the individual works beyond what is expected in the normal course of duties.
