

Winter 2020 Fear Free Practice SAT & ACT Tests

Juanita High School PTSA and The Princeton Review have partnered to provide students with the opportunity to take a Practice SAT and/or ACT test. Scores will be e-mailed directly to the student and are not reported to anyone else. Students return for a Test Review session 2½ weeks after taking the test.

Practice ACT Test

Test Session: Saturday, January 18, 2020 8:30 am – 1:00 pm

Registration Deadline: Tuesday, January 14, 2020 or until all spots are filled

Test Review Session: Thursday, January 30, 2020 7:00 pm – 8:30 pm

Practice SAT Test

Test Session: Saturday, March 21, 2020 8:30 am – 1:00 pm

Registration Deadline: Tuesday, March 17, 2020 or until all spots are filled

Test Review Session: Thursday, April 2, 2020 7:00 pm – 8:30 pm

Cost: \$20 per test

Location: Juanita High School Library

Bring: #2 pencils, water/snack, calculator
